HE'S SPECTACULAR stalked the pace along the inside, eased outside FOGGY MOUNTAIN leaving the far turn, rallied to take over in early stretch, opened a clear lead approaching the sixteenth pole, then was all out to hold STORM WARNINGS safe. The latter, reserved racing off the rail, angled to the inside for the stretch run and was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. FOGGY MOUNTAIN set the pace off the rail into the stretch, then gave way. BURNING TIME failed to menace. SCOTTISH COAST was no factor while racing three wide. WHISPER ONTHE WIND saved ground and faltered.
