HEDIS SASSY STAR showed speed, drifted out in front of CAERNACOPIA, then crossed back in in front of that rival on the first turn, made the pace off the rail, was headed by JEB'S LUCKY GIRL leaving the far turn, then came on again under pressure to prevail. JEB'S LUCKY GIRL advanced along the rail, moved to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, then was outgamed to the wire. HY STYLE unhurried early, rallied along the rail to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't gain late. CAERNACOPIA was forced out by HEDIS SASSY STAR on the first turn, then steadied when that rival crossed in front of him just past midway of the first turn, chased the pace into the stretch and weakened. BRUNSWICK BELLE chased the pace three wide to the far turn and tired. ARIEL ACTRESS was through early. SIBERGACE was always outrun, then collapsed and fell nearing the finish. Following a stewards inquiry, HEDIS SASSY STAR was disqualified and placed fourth for interference to CAERNACOPIA on the first turn.
