DON MISIL (ARG) was rated well placed off the early leaders, found ample room inside Max's Beau to challenge for command into the stretch, gained command nearing the furlong marker then drew off under pressure. MAX'S BEAU contested the pace slightly removed from the inside, resisted the winner briefly but ultimately proved no match while easily best of the rest. REXSON'S ROSE saved ground to the stretch, eased out and passed tired ones. JABBOK lagged from the outset and was never a factor. NOTE TO HARRY stalked the pace, retired after a half and tired badly. BEAUZEN came a bit wide into the stretch and was outrun. BROTHER JOEY flashed brief speed, stopped and was eased across the wire.
