**Footnotes**

BLACKJACK BEAUTY saved ground early, tipped out four wide leaving the backstretch, hooked up with Sweet Argument into the stretch then prevailed following a hard drive despite drifting near the end. SWEET ARGUMENT was hung four wide on the first turn, stalked the early pace, gained command near the three-eighths pole, held gamely when engaged by the winner and just missed following a long drive and despite out in late stretch. MANDATED TO WIN saved ground, eased out turning for home to loom within striking distance of the leaders but could not sustain her bid. IN HAUSER'S HANDS lagged early while saving ground then passed tired ones. RUTH WONDERS forced the early pace three wide, gained a short lead exiting the backstretch then steadily weakened. DUCHESS OF DOOM launched a rally outside rivals approaching the far turn, attempted to bear out hampering her rider around the second bend and fell back. AL'S ANGEL was outrun. PASADORA checked briefly at the break and was not a factor. ECSTATICALLY prompted the early pace, stopped to a walk and was eased to the wire. JESSE'S JADE hopped at the start and steadied, took up repeatedly while rank around the opening turn and was pulled up in early stretch.
