CHOSEN EMPIRE steadied in behind QUIZ WHIZ on the first turn, stalked that rival along the rail, slipped through inside that one to gain command in early stretch, then drew clear. MEAN SAX reserved racing along the inside, angled out leaving the far turn and closed to be up for the place while unable to gain on the winner. TRUST THE DEPUTY rated off the pace, saved ground while advancing into the stretch but couldn't stay with the top ones while gaining the show. REFLECTED CAT outran early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed with a mild response to finish on even terms with THE WACO KID. The latter, allowed to settle, was attempting to rally into contention when forced to steady in behind QUIZ WHIZ just past the eighth pole and failed to recover while dead heating with REFLECTED CAT. QUIZ WHIZ set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run and gave way. TROUBLES COMIN unhurried early, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then tired. SILVER CLOUD stalked the pace off the rail to the top of the stretch and faltered. FAST JAK stalked the pace three wide into the far turn, then faded.
