COMMANDER TATE tracked the pace three wide, rallied to gain command at the top of the stretch, then drew off under urging. DONT MESWIT GOLDIE reserved off the pace while saving ground, closed to prove second best while no match for the winner. JACKWAGON pressed the pace outside SANDALYE to the top of the stretch, then tired. BOMBINO tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch, then faltered. SANDALYE set the pace under pressure along the inside to the top of the stretch and faded. FORTUNATE BILL was through after a half mile and eased in the final eighth.
