STOMP disputed the pace lapped on Walt's Whiz from the outset, held a short advantage into the stretch and held sway following a long drive. WALT'S WHIZ dueled with the winner from the outset and succumbed grudgingly through the final furlong. HOW TO KNOW raced well placed but lacked a final response in an even effort. DANNY'S PRAYER dropped far back, came wide into the stretch and found his best stride too late. HE'S APPEALING slowest to begin, moved to a striking position down the backstretch but had no rally. FOOLISH HONOR was outrun. RARE RED BIRDS checked briefly at the break and was not a threat. SCORION came three wide into the stretch and had no rally. VARITEK showed little.
