Footnotes

FLYIN TREY stalked the pace from the outset, gained command near the three eighths pole, edged clear on the bend, settled into the stretch with a comfortable advantage then held safe Green Bluff under urging. GREEN BLUFF saved ground, checked briefly near the three eighths pole, angled four wide for clearance into the stretch and rallied belatedly outside. BARBARO'S REVENGE reserved three wide off the early leaders around the opening turn, moved to closer contention around the second turn but lacked a sufficient closing bid. EL LEGADO steadied from behind horses around the opening bend, moved four wide to challenge the leaders midway on the second turn but flattened out upon settling into the stretch. KING OF AMERICA raced wide around the second turn and had no rally. AUTHORITY RULES was no factor. STORM HARBOR sprinted to an easy lead, offered little resistance when challenged by the winner and steadily weakened after six furlongs. KARMANOS steadied sharply when pinched by Evil Powder after the start, lagged early, came wide into the stretch and was no factor. EVIL POWDER ducked out after the start to impede Karmanos, raced forwardly for a half, tired badly and was eased to the wire. IN SPEIGHT OF IT fanned out very wide into the stretch while far back.
