KIERNAN'S LEGACY raced well placed in the second flight, fanned a bid wide entering the stretch, ran down the weary leader near midstretch and proved clearly best. DECAF AGAIN checked back from between horses after the start, advanced between horses on the turn then finished willingly to be going best of all at the end. B L'S NOISE set a lively pace, held a long lead into the stretch but had nothing left once leaving the furlong grounds. DEALING LUCKY saved ground into the stretch, altered course behind Decaf Again near the eighth pole and outlasted the others. NEWS CARRIER dropped back after an alert beginning, raced wide and was not a serious factor. PUT IT BACK TWENTY saved ground while well placed to the stretch and tired. USAIN AGAIN showed little. HEY BYRN was always outrun.
