HIGH FLY chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the top of the stretch and drew off under urging. GOWER tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. WISECRACK vied for the lead outside DAN IS FAST to the top of the stretch and gave way. BLUE PEPSI LODGE rated off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and tired. DAN IS FAST vied for the lead along the inside to nearing the stretch and faltered. VIGOROUS GUY rated off the pace, faded in the drive. DILIGENT DON was outrun after hesitating at the start. MOSSEL BAY dwelt at the start, showed little and was eased in the final eighth. BAD BABY BUBBIE was done early and eased in the stretch run.
