WICKLOW VAMP was well placed for six furlongs, angled out on the turn, split rivals to challenge in midstretch and edged clear under good handling. SPECIAL REPORT settled three wide, ranged up from outside to gain a narrow lead on the turn, dueled into midstretch and held well for the place. IZTLA raced just off the pace while four wide, continued wide while gaining on the turn then finished evenly. ALISA'S HOPE pressed the early pace in the two path, gained a brief lead on the turn then weakened. P. J.'S ESKIMO failed to mount a serious rally while five wide. CARLSON'S QUEEN dueled along the rail to the turn and faltered. UNBRIDLED SKIP broke slowly, saved ground to the top of the stretch then drifted out while tiring.
