CHAMPAGNE ACCOUNT pressed the pace from outside, gained a slim lead at the quarter pole and edged away through the stretch. LAUGHING LUKE set the pace under pressure, relinquished the lead on the turn, swerved out in midstretch and held well for the place. WESTERN MAN rushed up after breaking slowly, angled three wide on the turn and rallied mildly. VINOTECH raced in the middle of the pack, swung five wide on the turn and tired. BACHELOR BLUES checked after being pinched early then raced wide. RUFUSTHEROADRUNNER showed speed for a half, circled six wide on the turn and gave way.
