ANDERSONSTATE rated on a short lead while kept off the rail, shook off his early pursuers before a half, repulsed a bid from On Appeal around the second bend, settled into the stretch with a commanding advantage and was ridden out to maintain a safe lead at the end. ENABLE saved ground while close up early, could not keep pace leaving the backstretch but continued on willingly from along the inside to be second best. SWIFT WARRIOR was pinched back and checked at the break, got caught between horses and was jostled by Motin and checked again on the opening turn, eased outside for clearance down the backstretch but never got untracked and passed only tired ones at the end. ON APPEAL raced close up while four wide during the early stages, took a run at the winner around the second turn, proved no match and steadily weakened. MOTIN bumped a couple of times with Swift Warrior while three wide on the first turn, saved ground around the second turn and was always outrun. I WANNA RUN steadied along from inside the winner on the opening turn, was prominent for five furlongs and tired.
