

MARINA DE CHAVON steadied in behind DOC'S HONEY in the early going, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and rallied under pressure to be up late. SKIP COMMAND rated off the pace, angled four wide on the far turn and rallied outside MARINA DE CHAVON to just miss. SEND THE PACKAGE stalked the pace, rallied along the hedge to gain the lead at the top of the stretch and opened a clear lead but couldn't resist the top ones in the closing strides. BLUE GRASS DANCER chased the pace three wide, made a run to gain brief lead on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE outrun early, swung out to avoid CHATTER CHATTER at the top of the stretch and passed tired rivals. DOC'S HONEY was no factor after being caught in tight early. CHATTER CHATTER set the pace off the rail, then was checked to avoid bumping rivals when she bore out at the top of the stretch and faltered. TUNE UP THE BAND chased the leaders four wide into the far turn and faded. TUSCANY LIGHT was through after a half mile.
