DOUBLE DECKER tracked the pace three wide around the turn, rallied to catch IMPORTUNO at the sixteenth pole and edged away. IMPORTUNO sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, then drifted out in midstretch and couldn't resist the winner late while holding the place. ZEBULON ROAD tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch and rallied for the show. PURELY GUILTY tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch but had no response when asked. TOUR DE COMPRISE raced three wide and failed to menace. SHEIK POLIS chased the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. DOING WITHOUT off slowly, was never a threat. PAPIRINGO was outrun. BACK AWAY was no factor after breaking poorly. JOHN THE BAPTIST saved ground after breaking slowly and was pulled up in the stretch when he bled. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN.
