Footnotes

FAN BASE stalked the pace off the rail, rallied to catch PRIMARY WITNESS nearing the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. PRIMARY WITNESS set the pace along the rail into the stretch but couldn't resist the winner while holding the place. NAVY WINGS reserved early, rallied to be up for the show. AUSSI AUSTIN rated off the pace while saving ground, angled out in the stretch and couldn't gain late. IMPERIAL ROBYN well placed while racing four wide, tired in the drive. SCOTTISH COAST off slowly, failed to menace. SHARKBAIT OOH HAHA stalked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faltered.
