PAY THE PREACHER vied for the lead along the inside, edged clear in early stretch, then was fully extended to hold off BEST OF THE REST. The latter, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, was outmoved by the winner, then didn't do enough late while continuing on with good courage for the place. BUILT UP vied for the lead outside PAY THE PREACHER to the top of the stretch and weakened. SEA OF TRANQUILITY tracked the pace four wide into the far turn, then lacked the needed late response. DANCING GUY rated in striking position off the pace, failed to rally. HIGH IDEAL tried to savage JUNIOR DEPUTY a couple of times racing into the first turn, raced four wide on the far turn and was not a factor. JUNIOR DEPUTY jostled by HIGH IDEAL when that rival tried to bite him a couple of times racing into the first turn, was outrun thereafter. SIR BEAR saved ground and faded.
