### Footnotes

TRICK ACT set the pace racing off the rail into the stretch, then drew off while being ridden out. SWEETNDANDY reserved early, advanced along the rail around the far turn to reach the attending position but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly best of the rest. DOUBLE HOLIDAY stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then gave way. GROTTTO was not a factor. FRESH ICE outrun early, raced three wide around the far turn and improved his position. SUPAH ALEX tracked the pace three wide into the far turn, then tired. SHOT GUN EDDIE L chased the pace into the far turn, then faltered. SANTA BEAR was outrun. GENERAL GUTI stalked the pace to midway of the far turn and faded. NORTHEN SWAN was through early.
