TONY BOLONEY vied for the lead three wide around the turn, was outmoved by NERVOUS MARVIN in the stretch, then came on again under pressure to be just up at the wire. NERVOUS MARVIN bobbled at the start, vied for the lead along the rail, edged away nearing the eighth pole, then just failed to last. EARLY ARGUMENT off slowly, chased the pace duel into the stretch and gave way. FAMILY HOLIDAY vied for the lead between horses into the stretch, then tired. OUR REPENT failed to menace after breaking slowly. SYO DEFENCEMAN was not a factor after breaking poorly. YUKON ERIC showed early foot and faltered. ZIP IT NANCE well placed early, faded. JET SETTIN PAPA was outrun after ducking out at the start. LEON ROYALE off slowly, trailed.
