Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2013 allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 5 lbs.; \$25,000 or two races other than maiden, claiming or starter, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. This race will be limited to 14 Starters with Also Eligibles. (High Weights Preferred). Supplemental Nominations at time of entry with a fee of \$1,500 to enter and start. Closed Saturday September 28, 2013 with 20 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).

AMEN KITTEN unhurried while saving ground, rallied along the hedge through the stretch to be up in time. MIDNIGHT CELLO steadied in the early going, stalked the pace, angled out in the stretch and rallied to be just up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. GRAND TITO stalked the pace three wide, moved up to press the pace outside PADILLA around the far turn and through the stretch, rallied to reach even terms for command in deep stretch but was edged to the wire in the closing strides by the top ones. PADILLA prompted the pace outside OFFLEE FAST, moved to take over from that rival soon after entering the far turn, maintained a slim advantage to deep stretch, then gave way. MANZUTTI rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and didn't do enough late. AYRTON reserved off the pace after being steadied from tight quarters in the early going, advanced along the inside to reach contention entering the far turn, then tired. OFFLEE FAST very hard to load into the gate, set the pace along the inside to the far turn and faltered. GRAD STUDENT was not a factor. UPTOWN ANTHEM was outrun after being caught in tight early. BOY OF SUMMER allowed to settle, made a run four wide to

reach contention entering the far turn, then faded. COLOSSIANS was through after a half mile.
