MISS MARONIE chased the pace, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole and edged away under pressure. RUNAWAY RIZZI unhurried early, angled outside the leaders for the drive and rallied to be up for the place. AIN'T IT SWEEP quickly sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace to past the eighth pole and gave way. PITCH A PENNY tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch and had no late response. DONT SAY NO SIERRA outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and failed to threaten. VOLUNTOWN rated off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and lacked a rally. LEGEND chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. SIMPLY JOLIE tracked the pace along the inside to midway of the turn, then faltered.
