Nominations for Stallions closed on February 15, 2004 with 136 Stallion Nominations. (No Supplementary Nominations). Closed Friday, May 11, 2007 with (824) nominations.

WISE ANSWER stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside INNER LIGHT to gain command on the far turn, then drew off under pressure. CIGAR MAN reserved racing along the inside, advanced around the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch but was no match for the winner while holding the place. CHECK IT TWICE unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals for the show. SIR DAVE outrun early, improved his position along the outside in the drive while never a threat. HONEY HONEY HONEY showed speed along the inside, was outmoted by INNER LIGHT on the backstretch, came on again to reach even terms for command on the far turn, then tired. BIG AL off slowly, stalked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then faltered. INNER LIGHT showed speed off the rail, opened a clear lead racing down the backstretch, made the pace into the far turn, then was fading when steadied from between rivals midway of the far turn. TRIPPLITE broke poorly and was through early.
