SOUTHCOTE ROAD unhurried early, advanced into contention around the far turn, angled out for the stretch run and rallied under pressure to be up late. BALLERINA BUNNY set the pace off the rail to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner while clearly best of the others. MS. FREIGHTSHAKER chased the pace to inside the eighth pole, then tired. ABBEY LIGHT up close racing along the rail, steadied to avoid running up on the leader on the first turn, slipped through inside that rival to reach even terms for command briefly on the backstretch, then was steadied entering the far turn and faltered. A SLICK CHIC chased the pace into the far turn and faded. BIANCA'S JEWEL was through after a half mile.
