Footnotes

PYRITE QUEEN tracked the pace three wide around the turn, rallied outside the drifting SPIRIT OF THE SOUL to take over nearing the sixteenth pole, then drew clear. CAPTURE THE SUN reserved racing along the inside, angled out for the drive and rallied to gain the place while unable to match strides with the winner. INDIAN SUMMER GIRL rated off the pace, raced off the rail and closed with a mild response to be up for the show. DODI N ME unhurried early, found her best stride late and just missed the show. SPIRIT OF THE SOUL showed speed off the rail, drew well clear on the turn, then drifted out through the stretch run and gave way. HONEST JENNIFER tracked the pace along the rail into the stretch and tired. EDITOR'S WILD NOTE outrun after being checked when she bumped with SEE THE PARADE at the start, failed to menace. SHOW US THE CHECK chased the pace into the stretch and faltered. SUNDAY WHIRL showed early foot, raced four wide on the turn and faded. SEE THE PARADE was no factor after bumping with EDITOR'S WILD NOTE at the start. RUCKUSLADY well placed early, raced five wide on the turn and stopped.
