GREEN VEGAS rated off the pace, rallied three wide around the far turn to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch, then was all out to prevail. WONDEROUS GLORY reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. IMAWILDANDCRAZYGUY allowed to settle, rushed up along the rail to gain a slim lead on the far turn, vied for the lead to inside the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. STRAIGHT FACED vied for the lead off the rail, responded when headed by IMAWILDANDCRAZYGUY on the far turn, continued to contest the pace to inside the eighth pole, then tired. CAPTAIN CAMERON unhurried early, made a run to reach contention on the far turn, then faltered. VILLAINAGE outrun after lunging at the start and nearly falling when he lost his footing, advanced into contention on the far turn, then had nothing left for the drive. HOLD'EM OR FOLD'EM vied for the lead outside STRAIGHT FACED into the far turn, then faded.
