COFFEE RUN unhurried racing along the rail, rallied through the stretch to be up in time. CANAIMA rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to take over at the eighth pole but couldn't hold off the winner in closing strides. APPELLA'S WONDER reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't gain late while up for the show. HOT CAPPUCINO off slowly, was rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and improved her position. SOLA GRATIA set the pace under pressure along the inside into the stretch, then weakened. MY PRECIOUS BABY stalked the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command approaching the eighth pole, then gave way. A LITTLE OFF stalked the pace along the inside into the far turn and tired. GOB SMACKED pressed the pace outside SOLA GRATIA into the stretch, then faltered. MISS MUFFIN allowed to settle, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention racing into the stretch, then faded.
