LUCKY IRISH DAY reserved while saving ground, angled outside the leaders in the stretch and rallied to be just up at the wire. SLIDING IN vied for the lead outside UPSHOTBEST, repulsed a bid from ASSORTED COLORS in the stretch, then just failed to last. ASSORTED COLORS broke a step slowly, moved up quickly to chase the pace three wide, was bothered when UPSHOTBEST forced SLIDING IN out a bit on the turn, came back on to try SLIDING IN at the eighth pole, then gave way in the final sixteenth. IN FOR A SONG allowed to settle, raced three wide around the turn and finished willingly. UPSHOTBEST vied for the lead along the rail to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. ROAD TO BABYLON failed to menace. BARON SLEW off slowly, saved ground around the turn and never threatened. FATHER LUCEY hit the gate at the start, chased the pace along the rail and tired. CLEVER CHRIS rated off the pace, had no response in the drive. INDIAN FROM SKY was outrun.
