**Footnotes**

DIXIE MATT was squeezed sat the start, allowed to settle in the back of the pace, was five wide in the final turn and offered a late outside rally for the win, was much the best. DEPUTY DANCE raced in close throughout, was three wide in the final turn, rallied and was up for place. WHODIDNTKNOWTHAT was in hand through the half and closed willingly in the mid stretch run. JOEY THE SCHOLAR race in the middle of the pack, offered a brief bid in the early stretch run and tired. SOUTHERN REVIEW was away alertly, dueled with SAMMYTHEREDROCKER at three sixteenths pole, made lead and was outfinished in the late stretch. CARTE BLANCHE broke in at the start, showed brief speed and was through after the half. STARSHIP STEVE failed to menace. DIXIE SLAM broke slow and was no threat. SAMMYTHEREDROCKER broke out at the start, dueled with SOUTHERN REVIEW at the three sixteenths pole and steadily retreated after. BLUEWATER CAT was no factor.
