REIGNING LIVIA unhurried early, angled to the outside in the stretch, then rallied to be up in time. SILENT WINTER pressed the pace three wide, moved to take over leaving the turn, opened a clear lead inside the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. BUNNY VALENTINE outrun after breaking slowly, angled to the outside in the stretch and closed to be up for the show. MEZUMAN chased the pace four wide to past the eighth pole, then gave way. THE NAZGUL RIDE showed speed off the rail, then couldn't stay with SILENT WINTER leaving the turn and tired in the final eighth. PATIENT APPROVAL saved ground and faltered. KOSA KOSA JAK reserved off the pace, faded in the drive.
