Footnotes

MIMITO BOY reserved off the pace, rallied and split rivals to gain the lead leaving the far turn, edged away in midstretch, then was fully extended to hold SASTRE safe. The latter, stalked the pace three wide, made a run with MIMITO BOY racing into the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival while continuing on with good courage to prove best of the rest. DREAMING OF LES set the pace along the inside to nearing the top of the stretch, then gave way. BARBARO'S REVENGE allowed to settle after breaking slowly, failed to menace. RIGHTEOUSHOPEFUL was not a factor. TIZANGELO rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. WAIT'N ON SUMTHIN stalked the pace along the rail into the far turn, then faded.
