Footnotes

BULL PRINCESS vied for the lead between horses into the stretch, then was all out to hold off COOK'N LIGHT. The latter, outrun early, raced four wide around the turn and rallied to just miss. MONARQUICA vied for the lead three wide to deep stretch and held on well while being edged to the wire. TWINING GLOW unhurried early, advanced into contention off the rail into the stretch, then couldn't gain late. ROSIES WILD LIPS off a step slowly, raced with the pace four wide into the stretch and weakened. SEAQUAY NINTY NINE vied for the lead along the rail to the quarter pole and tired. CHEEKS showed brief speed and faltered. MS. AMOURS bumped with SCOTTISH BUBBLY when caught in tight on the backstretch, steadied and was not a factor. SCOTTISH BUBBLY steadied when she bumped with MS. AMOURS in tight quarters on the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. LITTLE LAKE WIER was through early. TRICKSKI showed brief speed and faded while racing along the inside.
