RUPERT'S PROSPECT chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the top of the stretch and drew clear under pressure. TRULY APPEALING chased the pace along the rail, made a run to reach even terms for command at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. C. R. PACE showed speed off the rail into the stretch, gave way and finished on even terms with LA ROVERINA. The latter, rated off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, then closed along the outside to dead heat for the show. UNA MIRIM (BRZ) failed to menace after stumbling at the start. MISS IDA BELLE was not a factor. SOUTHER DIVISION chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered.
