STAKES Calder Derby Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start - with \$100,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$50,000 at a mile or over, 5 lbs.; \$35,000 or non-winners of two races other than Maiden, Claiming or Starter at a mile or over, 7 lbs. Graded placed horses at equal weights preferred. Graded stakes winners preferred. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Two (2) Supplemental Nominations of \$3,000 to enter and start. Closed Saturday, October 3, 2009 with 14 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).

**Footnotes**

SAL THE BARBER stalked the pace three wide, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole and was fully extended to prevail. GRAND CASH unhurried after breaking slowly, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and made a run to reach near even terms for command at the sixteenth pole but was edged to the wire. LIVINGSTON STREET rated off the pace, saved ground to nearing the stretch, angled out for the drive and closed well to just miss the place. QUIET EMARATI stalked the pace along the hedge, slipped through inside REGIS to reach near even terms for command at the eighth pole, then tried that rival to the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. REGIS set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run while continuing to make the pace to nearing the sixteenth pole, then weakened. POUND FOOLISH pressed the pace outside REGIS into the stretch, then gave way. STATELY CHARACTER raced in striking position three wide to nearing the stretch, then faltered. JUST LIKE BISCUIT failed to menace. SCORBIT off slowly, was never a factor.
