MAMBO MEISTER stalked the pace, rallied four wide to take over entering the stretch, then drew away under urging. MOTOVATO unhurried after breaking slow and clipping heels at the start, advanced between horses around the far turn to reach contention but couldn't stay with the winner while closing to prove second best. PECHITO (ARG) set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. DREAM MAESTRO allowed to settle, raced four wide around the far turn and failed to menace. COLONIAL CAUSEWAY rated in striking position off the pace, faltered in the drive. TEMO'S DREAM tracked the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then faded. HEY BYRN chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then had nothing left. LADY SHATZI (PER) trailed.
