Footnotes

MAJESTIC MOOD steadied in behind D J K STORM on the first turn, then steadied in traffic on the backstretch and again in behind SALT FLAKE on the far turn, rallied to catch SCRIPT nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away under urging. SCRIPT angled in leaving the first turn to make the pace along the inside and continued on with good courage for the place while being outfinished by the winner. D J K STORM steadied in behind SALT FLAKE on the first turn, then was steadied between rivals on the backstretch, raced four wide on the far turn and closed to be up for the show. WANDOFWANDS outrun early, improved her position without threatening. GOLDEN COMMODITY tracked the pace into the stretch and weakened. SHES JUST COOL advanced along the outside around the first turn, moved up to press the pace around the far turn, then tired. LIVING ON THE LINE rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and faltered. SALT FLAKE steadied leaving the first turn and again entering the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
