FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start - with \$100,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. This race will be limited to 12 Starters, with Also Eligibles (High Weights Preferred). Closed Saturday, October 4, 2008 with 22 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile).

SOLDIER'S DANCER reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole, then drew away. WISE RIVER tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while unable to match strides with the winner. FAIR WEATHER STAN allowed to settle, saved ground into the stretch, angled out and closed to gain the show while no threat to the top one. MAGIC MECKE rated off the pace after breaking awkwardly, saved ground while advancing into the stretch but couldn't keep pace with the top ones. MR. SILVER moved up on the backstretch to vie for the lead between horses into the stretch, then gave way. A. P. MAGIC made a run to engage the leaders three wide on the backstretch, contested the pace into the stretch and tired. QUISTOPHER showed speed along the hedge, responded when challenged on the backstretch, vied for the lead into the stretch, then faltered. SERAPI CAT failed to menace. JUSTIN RULES was not a factor. REXSON'S ROSE tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and faded.
