Footnotes

BIG DRAMA stalked the pace after being steadied in behind THREE PART HARMONY leaving the first turn, slipped through inside that rival to gain the lead on the far turn, then drew off under urging. THREE PART HARMONY set the pace off the rail into the far turn, then was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. EDGEMOOR stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. SINCERO unhurried after being steadied from tight quarters at the start, raced four wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals. THIS ONES FOR PHIL rated off the pace, raced in contention four wide around the far turn and tired. MESHUGA well placed into the far turn, faltered. STORM SLEW was not a factor. SLEW OF SMOKE chased the pace into the far turn and faded. SAYERS steadied in the run to the first turn, was through after a half mile and eased in the final eighth. AMBUSCADER reserved off the pace, stopped leaving the far turn and was pulled up in the stretch. DRYDEN outrun after stumbling badly at the start, was pulled up in the stretch and vanned off.
