**Footnotes**

STARSHIP BALLERINA unhurried after being checked to avoid COME SEE COME SA soon after the start, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied to take over late and won going away. SING ME A LULLABY was knocked into RED LACE soon after the start, then steadied from close quarters soon after, moved up along the outside down the backstretch to chase the pace into the stretch, then wore down TALAVISTA for the place while being outfinished by the winner. TALAVISTA steadied along the inside on the first turn, rallied to take over leaving the backstretch and opened a clear lead, then bobbed around the quarter pole, maintained her advantage to inside the sixteenth pole and gave way. ILL CONSIDERED prompted the early pace, chased the leaders into the stretch, then weakened. SCORPION BRIDE failed to menace. RED LACE was knocked sideways in the early going causing her rider to lose his right iron, then bore out leaving the first turn before her rider was able to recover his iron and was not a factor thereafter. PINAFRA was outrun after being steadied to avoid COME SEE COME SA in the early going. COME SEE COME SA veered in soon after the start impeding a couple of rivals and knocking SING ME A LULLABY into RED LACE, sprinted to a clear lead while angling over to the rail, made the pace to nearing the far turn, then faded.
