HELLO MECKE rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away. FOREIGN RUCKUS unhurried while saving ground, rallied along the rail through the stretch to be up for the place. SPIKEAVELLIAN vied for the lead along the inside, was outmoved by DIMELO on the far turn but wore that rival down for the show while being outfinished by the top ones. DIMELO vied for the lead outside SPIKEAVELLIAN, edged clear from that rival on the far turn while moving to the inside, made the pace to inside the eighth pole and gave way. SIR OSO tired from good position. THE MOVE MAN was not a factor. STOWER chased the pace into the far turn and faltered. BOMBAY showed little.
