WIN GRAMMY BOY reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be just up at the wire. RUSTY CHARLIE chased the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead in deep stretch, then just failed to last. DIRTKICKER chased the pace three wide around the turn, rallied inside MULHERENGO to gain a brief lead at the sixteenth pole but was edged to the wire. HELICOPTER off slowly, raced four wide around the turn, swung out widest of all for the stretch run and was gaining at the finish. EDDIE'S INK chased the pace into the stretch and weakened. MULHERENGO showed speed three wide into the stretch and tired. INVISIBLE POND off slowly, was not a factor. BEGREATCAT saved ground after breaking slowly and faltered. STICKY TUT was outrun after being checked leaving the chute. YOUNOWHATTODO was outrun. ATTIC INDIAN showed early foot and faded.
