Footnotes

WILKO'S BULLET tracked the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to take over entering the stretch and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to remain clear to the wire. LAUNCH reserved racing along the inside, eased out on the far turn and rallied to prove best of the rest. GIVE ME LIBERTY pressed the pace inside OUR KASHMIR, took over from that rival racing into the far turn, made the pace to nearing the stretch, then gave way. DROID TEMPTATION unhurried early, advanced into contention on the far turn, then tired. SLEEPING BULL stalked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch and faltered. CUM LAUDE reserved off the pace, faded in the drive. OUR KASHMIR set the pace while trying to get out leaving the first turn and down the backstretch, then bore out leaving the far turn and was eased in the stretch run. TEN POINTER was stalking the pace when he bolted on the far turn and was pulled up.
