HELLO POOCHI POOH rated off the pace after breaking awkwardly, raced three wide around the turn and rallied to be just up at the wire. GOLDA'S DREAM set the pace, responded when challenged by GLITTER EXPRESS, bumped soundly with that rival in early stretch, then dueled with that one to deep stretch and just failed to last. BROTHERLY LOVE reserved off the pace, steadied from tight quarters on the backstretch, then rallied along the inside in the drive to just miss the place. GLITTER EXPRESS chased the pace, bumped hard with GOLDA'S DREAM in early stretch while rallying to reach the lead, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and was outfinished. SARA'S HOT SHOT unhurried early, raced four wide around the turn and closed with a belated rally. DE JEWEL tracked the pace around the turn and tired. VIVA LA SLEW showed early foot along the inside and faltered. FREE TO SWEEP off slowly, was no factor while racing four wide.
