BELLEFIRE unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied to be up in the final strides. COZY KITTEN rated off the pace, eased out for the stretch run, rallied to gain a brief lead late but couldn't resist the winner in the closing yards. MAJESTIC EXPRESS reserved off the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then weakened late. BALINO set the pace along the hedge into the stretch and gave way. NO LIFT SHIFT stalked the pace three wide into the far turn, then tired. EL ROMANO was not a factor. CHARLIE IN CHARGE stalked the pace, eased in to saved ground around the far turn and faltered. TWO IS TO MANY up close early, faded.
