MONTESSA G quickly sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the stretch, then remained clear to the wire under pressure. ARABELLA'S TUNE chased the winner off the rail into the stretch but couldn't get to that rival while clearly second best. SINISTER BREW reserved early, couldn't keep pace with the top ones while edging QUEEN CONCERTO for the show. The latter, outrun after breaking slowly, failed to menace while just missing the show. MISS CEDAR KEY was not a factor. OBRIGETA rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and faltered. PERFECT'S LIL SIS bore out on the first turn, rushed up racing into the backstretch to track the leaders into the far turn, then faded and was eased in the stretch run.
