Footnotes

MR. ESPRESSO rated off the pace, eased to the rail for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. IMPERIAL ROBYN reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to gain a brief lead nearing the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while just saving the place. AMERICAN LEGEND unhurried early, steadied while trying to come between horses on the far turn, angled out in the stretch and closed well to just miss the place. CHIPTease chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the far turn, then tired in the drive. SCOTTISH COAST steadied soon after the start, saved ground and failed to menace. SUGAR RYAN raced four wide and was not a factor. DYNAMIC BOY raced three wide and faltered. WINNINGISGOOD outran CHIPTease for the lead around the first turn and eased to the inside, made the pace to nearing the quarter pole, then faded.
