SORBET chased the pace from the outside, rallied to catch RUDI'S LESLIE nearing the sixteenth pole and drew clear. RUDI'S LESLIE quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside to past the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner late while holding the place. DINNER SWEETS outrun after breaking slowly, closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. FLY ME ALI chased the pace into the stretch and tired. CAJULENA well placed racing along the inside, steadied from close quarters entering the turn, swung out for the stretch run and faltered. OUR EXPLOIT off slowly, was no factor while racing three wide. ZIP ZIP BOOM showed early foot, moved to the inside entering the turn, then faded.
