YELLOW BRICK ROAD rushed to the lead after the start, set the pace and led throughout, finished as rider pleased. MAXIMOSO raced in the back of the pack and made a steady advance, went four wide in the final turn and finished well. YELLENA'S VISION was never far back from the leaders, went three wide in the final turn, offered a brief bid and gave way in the stretch. UNFLAPABLE raced at the back of the pack, went five wide in the final turn and offered his best stride late. TWO SAINTS pressed the pace into the final turn and was used up for the stretch run. WAT was in contention and flattened out after the half. PUCHADOR broke in and bumped SCORION at the start, showed brief foot and stopped, passed tiring rival. SCORION was bumped at the start by PUCHADOR, showed brief speed and was through after the half.
