Footnotes

KISS A NATIVE prompted the pace along the rail, moved to take over command after entering the far turn, then drew clear through the stretch run under steady urging. SNUCK IN steadied and checked in behind the leaders on the first turn, remained in striking position around the far turn, angled outside the winner at the top of the stretch and continued on with good courage to prove second best. MEGACLES dwelt and broke in the air at the start, rallied strongly while swinging wide into the stretch to loom a threat, then flattened out. ELITE MERCEDES rated close up, angled four wide leaving the far turn and weakened. WHATA BRAINSTORM dwelt at the start and was not a factor. END LEADER reserved early, made a run three wide to reach the attending position on the far turn and tired. FROZEN FIELD set the pace racing off the rail and stopped. COCKTAILS AND LIES showed little and was eased in the stretch run.
