B L'S APPEAL rallied four wide on the turn to gain command, then drew off under urging. SWEEPING ANALYSIS reserved early, raced three wide around the turn and proved second best. SYKES ALIVE broke a step slowly and bumped with CHEROKEE CROWN, made a run along the rail to reach near even terms for command on the turn, then tired. HOME SILVER prompted the pace three wide, drew even on the turn and faltered. PURE CLASS failed to menace after breaking poorly. IMAGE AND ISSUES was outrun after being steadied when he broke in at the start. CHEROKEE CROWN bumped at the start, was never close. MR. PENTEL set the pace racing off the rail and stopped.
