B. B. BEST outran DANCE TO REMEMBER around the first turn to gain the lead, made the pace along the inside, drew clear on the far turn, then drifted out through the stretch and was fully extended to hold ANTHONY J. safe. The latter, allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run and closed well for the place. CLOSING ARGUMENT eased back to stalk the pace after bumping with DANCE TO REMEMBER entering the first turn, raced three wide on the far turn and weakened in the drive. ALEXANDERSRUN reserved early, advanced into contention five wide on the far turn, then flattened out. DANCE TO REMEMBER bumped with CLOSING ARGUMENT entering the first turn, was outmoved by the winner, chased that rival to nearing the stretch, then gave way. DUSTY MINISTER outrun early, raced five wide on the far turn and was not a factor. CIN CIN rated off the pace, dropped back on the far turn and failed to menace. HAL'S IMAGE tracked the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and tired. CAPTAIN CORELLI tracked the pace, advanced four wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then faltered in the drive. FAVRE steadied in the run to the first turn, raced in contention along the inside into the far turn, was steadied again approaching the quarter pole and failed to recover. QUREALL raced in striking position into the far turn, then faded. HOSTILE WITNESS

was outrun. CHEROKEE CHASE was through early and eased in the stretch run.
